

105946 - Giving zakah to charitable organisations to distribute

the question

Is it permissible to pay zakat directly into the accounts of the charitable organizations, while there are people in the same city where I live who might deserve it?.

Detailed answer

It is permissible to transfer zakah money into the accounts of charitable organisations so that they can distribute it if the people in charge of that are trustworthy and will give the zakah to the classes of people who are entitled to it according to sharee'ah.

The basic principle concerning zakah is that it should be given to the poor in the country in which the money is. If it is necessary to transfer it elsewhere, such as if the poor people in the country to which it is transferred are in greater need or they are relatives of the person who is giving zakah in addition to being poor, and so on, then it is permissible to send it.
