

3475 - Should the imam appoint someone to take his place if his prayer becomes invalid?

the question

If something happens to the imam (he breaks his wudoo'), is it permissible for one of the members of the congregation to take over and lead the others in prayer?

Detailed answer

If the imam loses his wudoo' and stops praying, he can say to one of the members of the congregation, "O so and so, come forward and finish leading them in prayer." If he does not do this, then the worshippers can appoint one of their number to finish leading the prayer, or they can complete the prayer individually.
