

9112 - His father killed his mother; can he take the inheritance from him on the basis that it is diyah (blood money)?

the question

My father murder my mother when i was very young 15 years old. Both my mother and father are kafir and i was a kafir at that time. My father never went to prison for the crime, now he is very old and may die soon. He is planning to leave me a lot of money. Can i accept this money? Can it be considered blood money?

Detailed answer

We

put this question to Shaykh Muhammad ibn Saalih al-'Uthaymeen, may Allaah preserve him, who answered as follows:

If

he is going to give it to you on the basis that it is diyah (blood money), then you should not take it, because he is a kaafir and you are a Muslim; a Muslim cannot inherit from a kaafir, and diyah is a kind of inheritance. If he is going to give it to you just to make you feel better (as a gift), then there is nothing wrong with taking it. And Allaah knows best.
